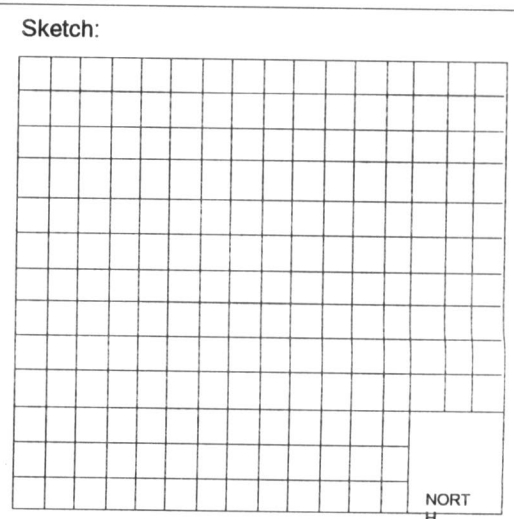

Description: Central hexagonal section with multi-part hip roof. Long rectangular extensions from two opposite sites; one is an open porch area, the other is an enclosed work/office area. Exterior walls slant at approximately 80 degrees. Lantern roof extends from the center of the main roof.

Historical Data: Owned by C. Leigh Stevens, president of the Savannah River Lumber Corporation, in late 1930s. Commissioned Frank Lloyd Wright to design the main buildings and outbuildings. Completed between 1940 and 1950.



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
