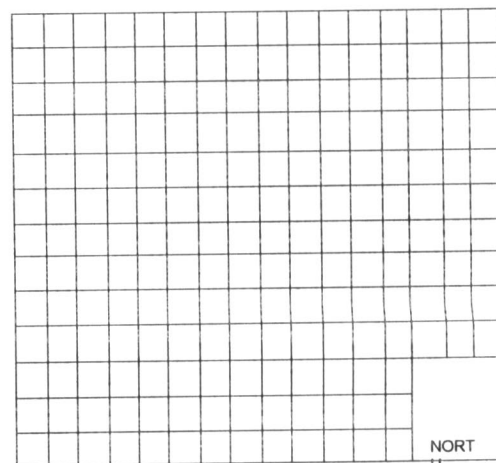

Description: Small irregularly shaped caretaker's house. Roof has four distinct pitches, rising to a point at two ends. Walls, like the main house are slanted at 80 degrees from the ground. Partially screened porch on two front sides of the house.

Historical Data: Owned by C. Leigh Stevens, president of the Savannah River Lumber Corporation, in late 1930s. Commissioned Frank Lloyd Wright to design the main buildings and outbuildings. Completed between 1940 and 1950.
