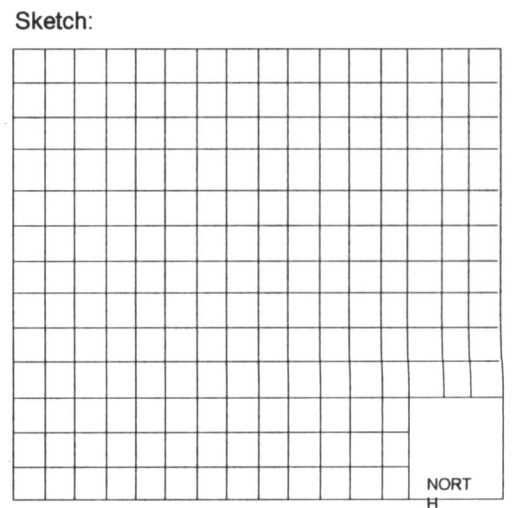

Historical Data: Designed and built by William T. White, a Charleston stonecarver, for Edgar Fripp. Fripp was a planter and owned Seaside Plantation until his death in 1860. The mausoleum had been built by 1865, as there are reports of the mausoleum being ransacked during the Civil War.
