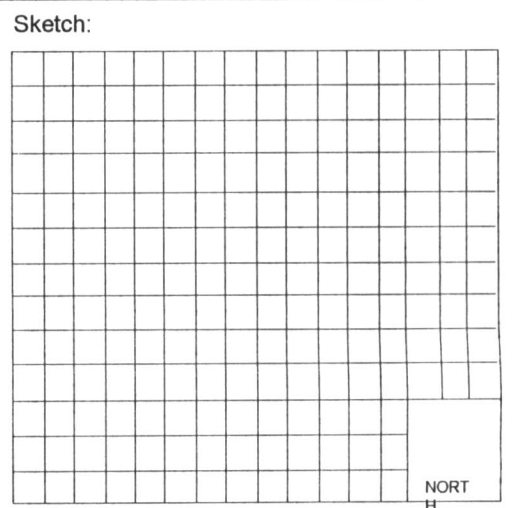

Description: Central 1-bay section, roof flares out on each side to form a shed roof over open side wings.

Historical Data: Barn for the McLeod truck farm. The McLeod farm was one of the most important of the rapid increase of truck farms throughout the South Carolina Lowcountry, and is one of the best extant examples of a turn of the century truck farms in the state. The farm began in 1884 when William H. McLeod and his son, Claudius E. McLeod bought land along the west side of the new Port Royal and Augusta Railroad.
