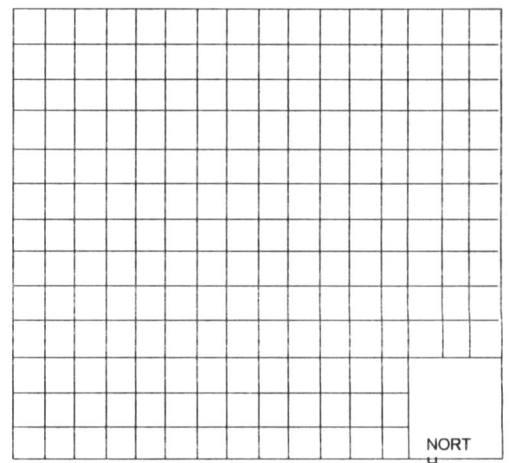

Description: Rectangular building with wood frame, open on gable end, wide door on side.

Historical Data: Used by the McLeod truck farm to weigh produce before being shipped. The McLeod farm was one of the most important of the rapid increase of truck farms throughout the South Carolina Lowcountry. The farm began in 1884 when William H. McLeod and his son, Claudius E. McLeod bought land along the west side of the new Port Royal and Augusta Railroad.
