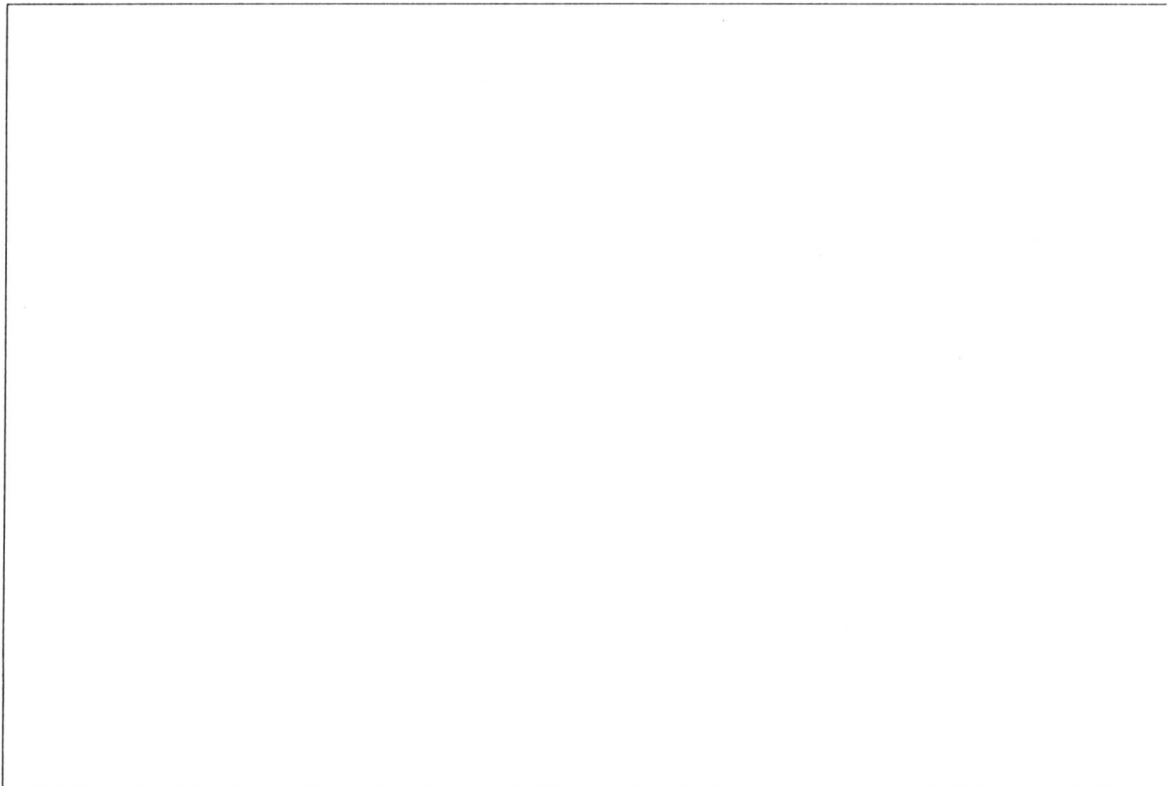

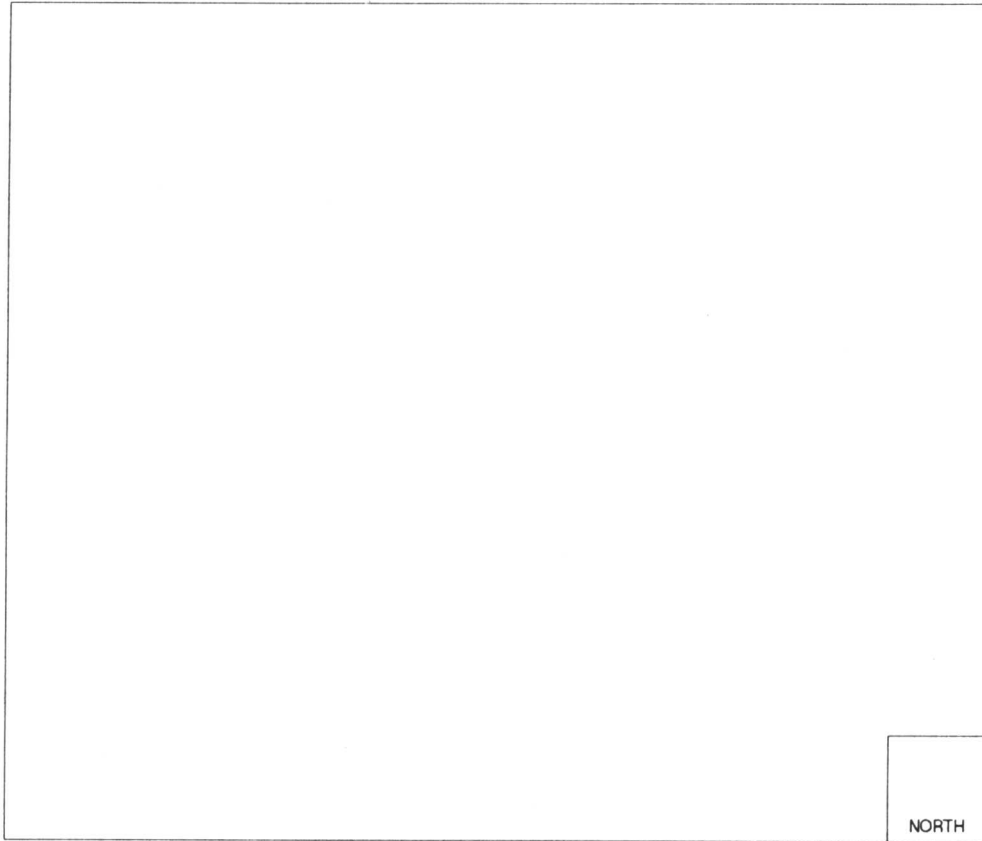

Dams have been widened and resurfaced; trunk gates have been replaced with gates of modern treated lumber, configured like historic gates. The dikes nearest the Combahee River have been reinforced with bulwarks of modern treated lumber.
