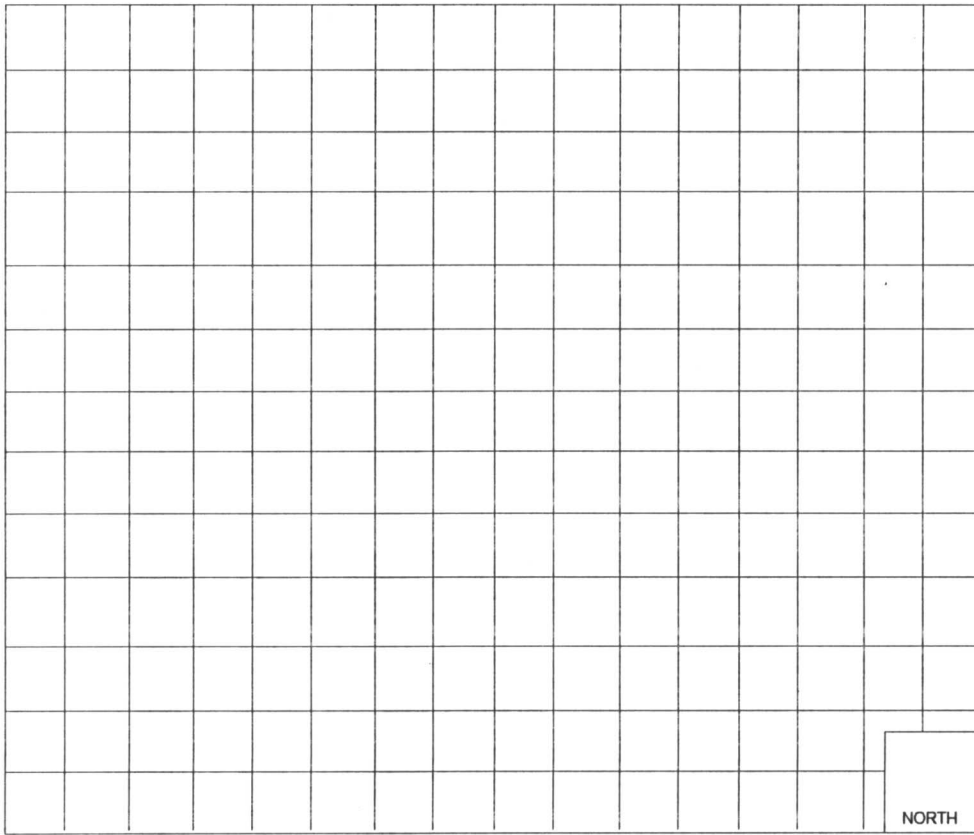

Nieuport first acquired ca. 1760 by Henry Middleton; remained in Middleton-Cheves family until 1929 when it was sold as 3670 acres. 1887-1913 planted by Landon Cheves and F. W. Colcock. Newport Plantation part of Eugene Dupont III's Nemours Plt., formed in 1962 from Nieuport, Green Point, Clay Hall, Newberry, Dawsons, Pringle and True Blue, a total of 9800 acres. Owned by Nemours Wildlife Foundation. 1863 Union forces reached as far as Nieuport.
