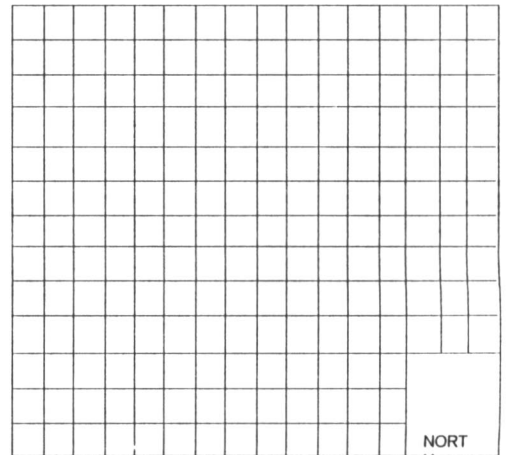

1-room, 1-story addition to rear, features exposed rafter tails.

Description: Large 2-story temple front church. 4-bay facade; first floor unevenly spaced with 2 windows and 2 double doors. Second story has 4 evenly spaced windows. Porch formed by gable projecting beyond facade to form temple front; supported by 4 tall square wooden posts set on short masonry piers. Returned eaves on front. 6 window bays deep on side.

Historical Data: May have been built as an offshoot from the Euhaws Baptist Church; the church had members on Lady's Island by 1799.
