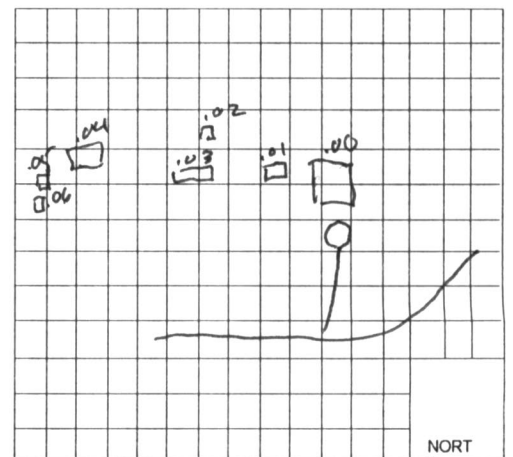

Description: Large 2.5 story side gabled house set on brick piers. Original part is two rooms deep; there are additions to the rear of the original house. Projecting 2-story porch with tiers, under a pediment featuring a lunette. Five bay facade with a central door.

Historical Data: Property had been owned from early 18th century, by Middletons, Izards, Heywards. Original plantation destroyed in Civil War; purchased in 1878 by Maj. John H. Screven.
