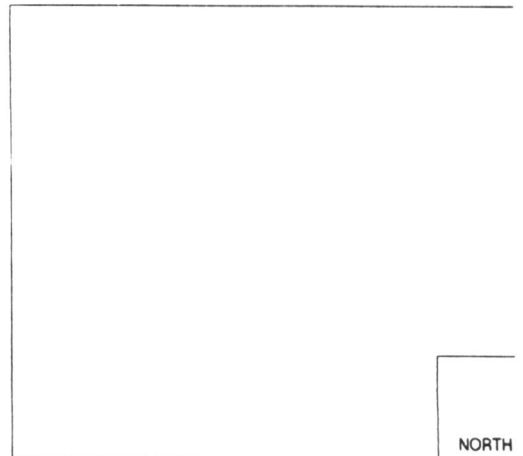

Description: One-story rear shed wing. 49' square light tower extends gable end wall; octagonal glass and metal lamp housing with slat balustrade along outside catwalk supported by carved brackets.
 Outbuildings: Cistern adjacent to house, built 1895; brick structure, above and below-ground, filled by well. Brick footings of former pumphouse at site of well.

Historical Data: Built on foundation of ca. 1790-1820 tabby mansion. Constructed as keeper's dwelling and rear range light marking the entrance into Calibogue Sound. The front light was a separate small tower that rested on a movable foundation.
 The light was de-activated and property sold, 1924.
