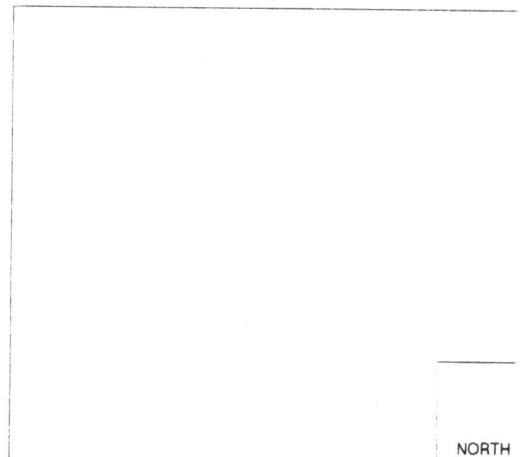

Description: Front gable dormer with window, originally location of lamp.

Historical Data: Light at south end of island marking mouth of New River and the Savannah River Channel. This is keeper's residence and front light; the rear range light was near the oil house. The light was housed in the front dormer room.
