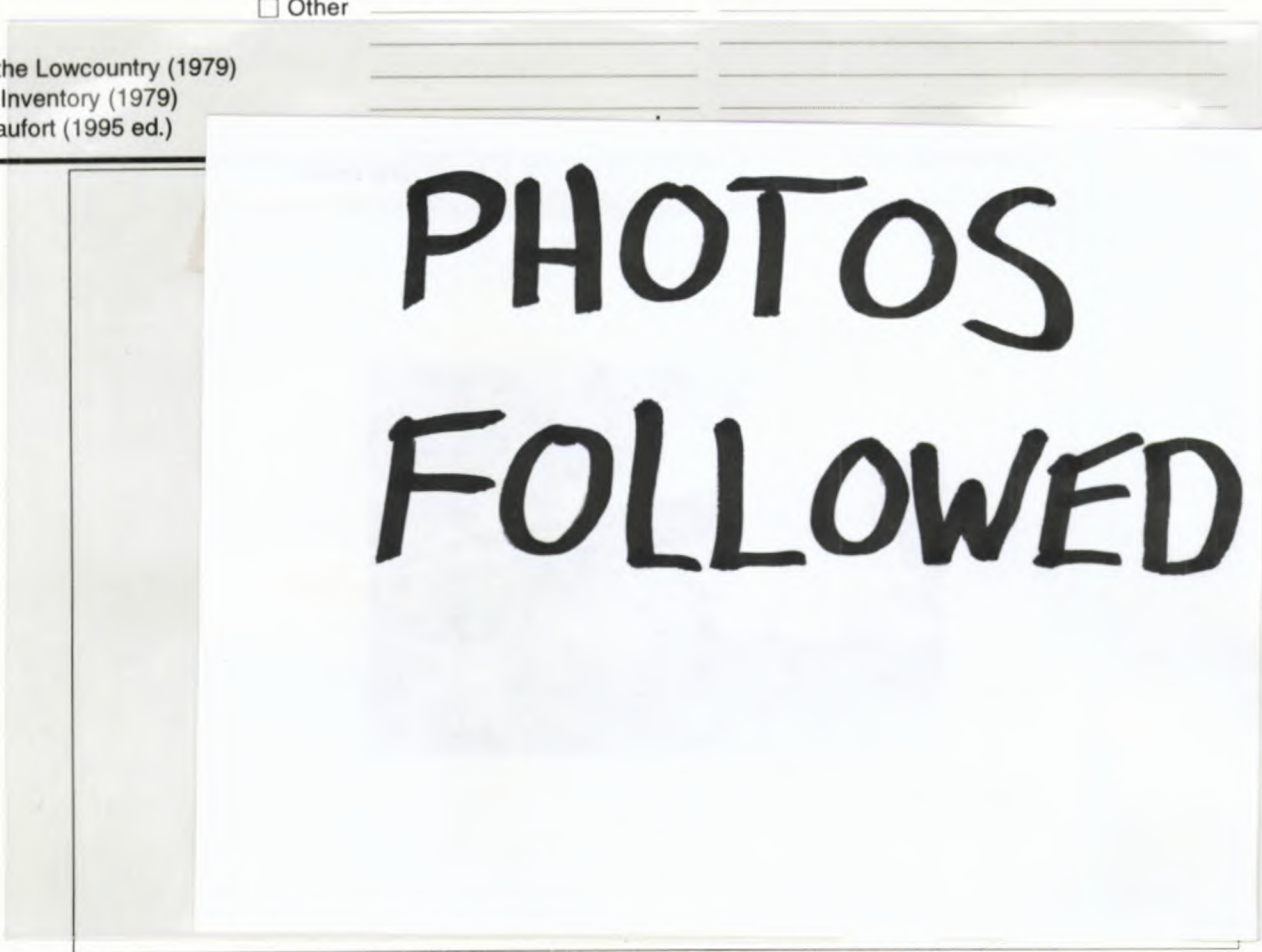

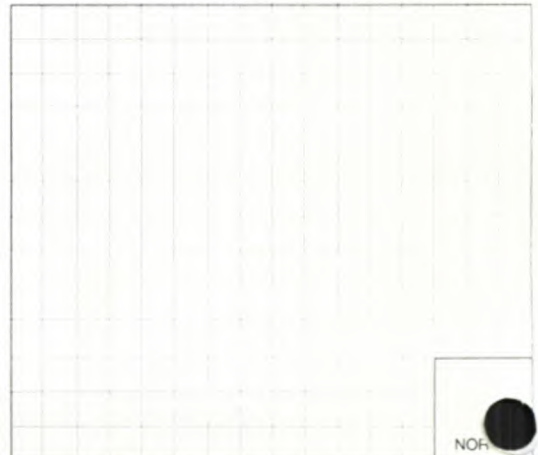

Description: Rectangular 1 story 3 x 2 bay frame dwelling w/lateral gable raised seam metal roof. 1-story T wing at rear. Boxed cornice. Shed porch across facade w/beaded board siding at ends, posts w/sawn brackets. Central entrance at facade flanked by 6/6 double hung sash windows. Two 6/6 windows at each side elevation.

Historical Data: The building is shown on the 1905, 1913 and 1924 Sanborn maps. The rear T wing shows as a separate building (possibly a kitchen) attached to the house by a breezeway.
