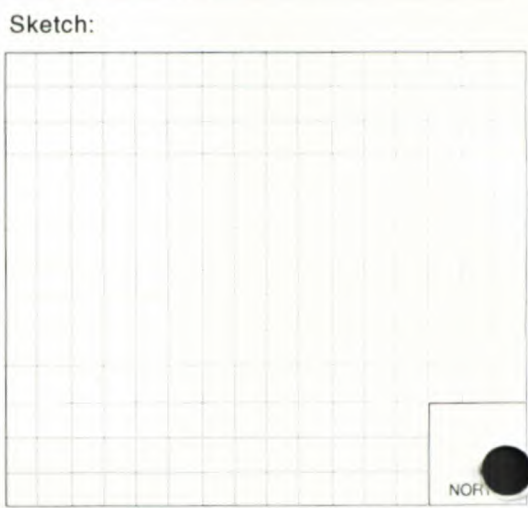

Description: 2 story rectangular 3 x 3 bay frame dwelling w/front-facing gable roof; 2 x 2 bay frame wing at rear 2 bays of E elev.; 1x1 bay rear wing. Roof has 1 historic ridge vent, 1 recent vent, an interior brick chimney, and a boxed cornice w/returns. The upper tier of the porch has been screened. The principal entrance, with transom & sidelights, is located in the E bay of the 1st level of the facade. Remaining bays have single 6/6 double hung sash windows. Side elevations have similar windows. The wing has a side-facing gable roof and a boxed cornice with returns. A former engaged porch at its facade has been infilled.
