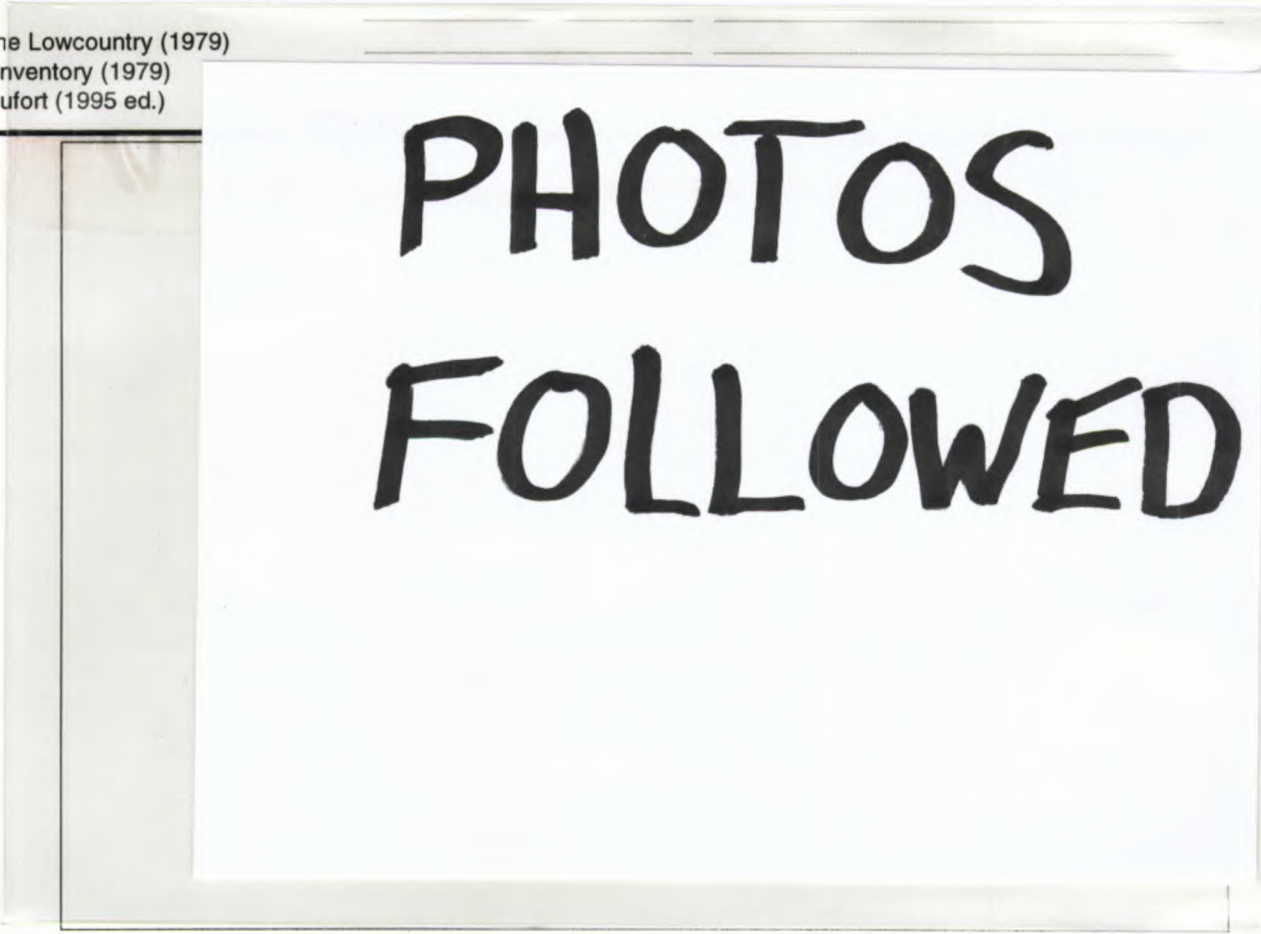

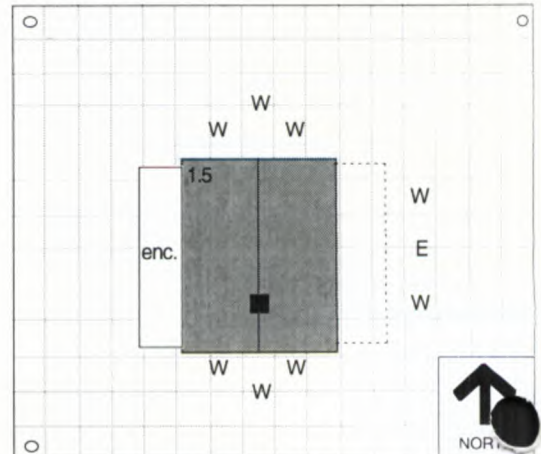

Description: Rectangular 1.5-story frame 3 x 2 bay dwelling w/lateral gable roof. Full-facade shed porch w/chamfered posts and replacement railing. Central entrance at facade flanked by 6/6 double hung sash windows. 6/6 windows at each bay of side elevs. and at gable ends. Rear 1 x 2 bay wing at N. Site retains contributing frame garage.

Historical Data: Similar to adjacent houses at 906 and 908 10th Street. House and garage are shown on a 1920 plat of Port Royal by A. O. Christensen.

Christensen Notes refer to the site as "P. R. Antique House" and list the following chain of title: Daniel F. Appleton to H. L. Krouse, 3/17/1892; H. L. Krouse to Katie Santos, 9/6/1916; Katie Santos to M. E. & Eva Lea, 9/23/1916; M. E. & Eva Lea to H. G. Burckmeyer, 3/18/1926; H. G. Burckmeyer to J. O. Williams, 6/1/1926 [this information not verified].
