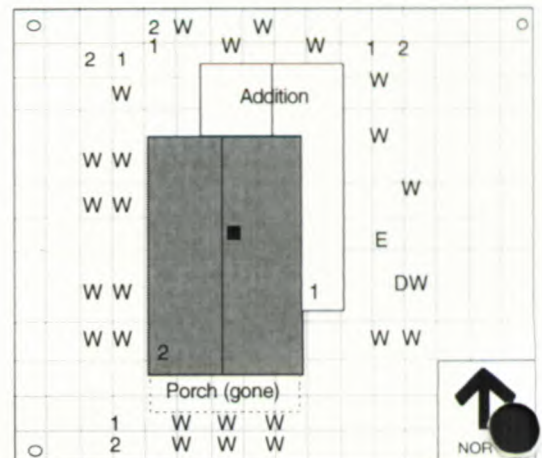
Description: Rectangular 2 story frame 3 x 4 bay dwelling w/front facing gable roof; rear 1.5 story gable addition

Historical Data: Shown on the 1924 Sanborn Map; area not included on the 1905 and 1912 maps. House is shown on a 1920 plat of Port Royal by A. O. Christensen.

Christensen Notes refer to the site as "Black/Read/Caldwell House" and list the following chain of title: Daniel F. Appleton to Port Royal Land Co., no date; Port Royal Land Co. to G. Black, 1920; G. Black to Hazel Black, 10/7/1931 [this information not verified].

According to Vonna Caldwell, present owner, the house was built circa 1900 for H. R. Walker and originally it had porch that has been missing for many years.
