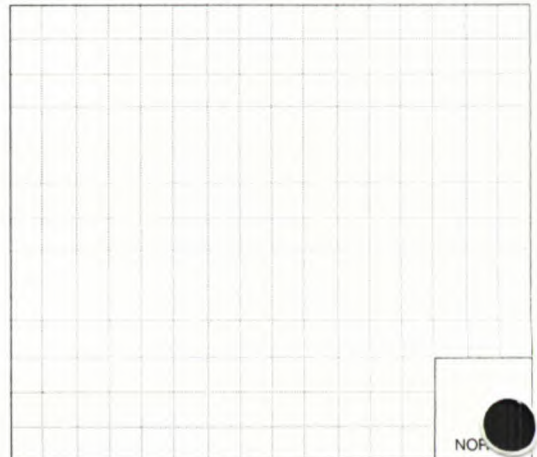

Description: L shaped 1 story frame dwelling w/cross gable raised seam metal roof; rear ell wings at E & W sides w/recent infill between. Full facade porch w/chamfered posts , slat balustrade & sawn brackets wraps to 1st 3 bays of E elev. Facade has an entrance in its 2nd bay (from W) and single 6/6 double hung sash windows in remaining bays. W elev. has a central single original 6/6 window and a later small profile 6/6 wind to the N. The W ell has a double 6/6 window in the S bay of its W elev. and a single 6/6 window in the northern bay. The E elev. has an entrance in its center bay flanked by 6/6 windows. There is a small frame shed to the rear of the property.

Historical Data: The house is partially shown on the 1924 Sanborn Map. House is shown on a 1920 plat of Port Royal by A. O. Christensen.
