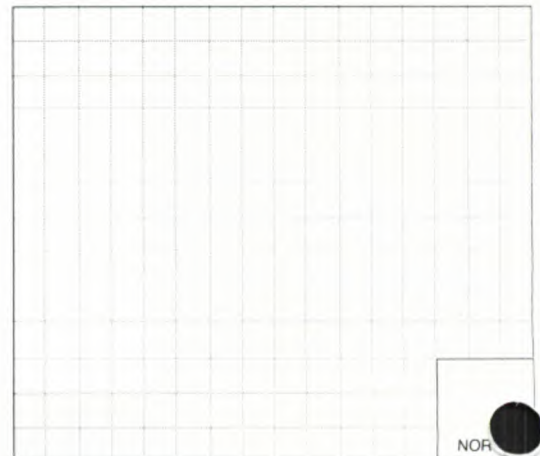

Description: Rectangular 2 story frame 3x2 bay dwelling w/lateral gable roof; entrance bay only porch at facade; 1x1 bay gable wing at S end of E elev.; 2-tier porch along rear is partially infilled; 1 story kitchen building at rear-center now attached by infill. Facade has central entrance w/transom & sidelights flanked by single 6/6 windows. 6/6 windows in each bay of 2nd level and at side elevs.

Historical Data: The house is shown on the 1920 Christensen plat of Port Royal; the area is not included in Sanborn maps
