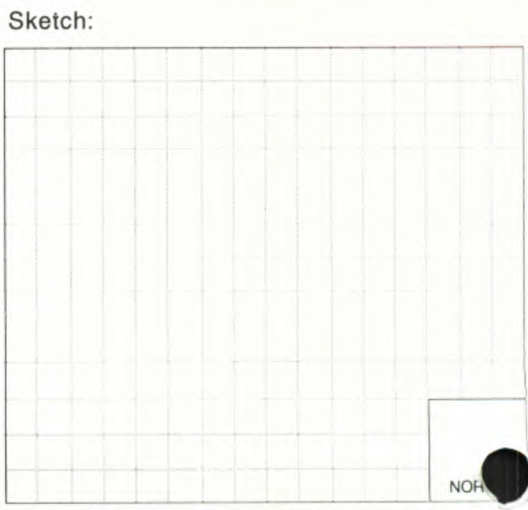

Description: Rectangular 5 x 1 bay frame 1 story dwelling w/lateral gable raised seam metal roof and full facade porch; rear full-width 3-bay deep shed addition. Western 2 bays of porch now infilled. Remaining bay s of porch retain chamfered posts & slat balustrade. Central entrance at facade w/two 6/6 windows to the E. Side elevations have replacement windows and rectangular louvered attic vents
