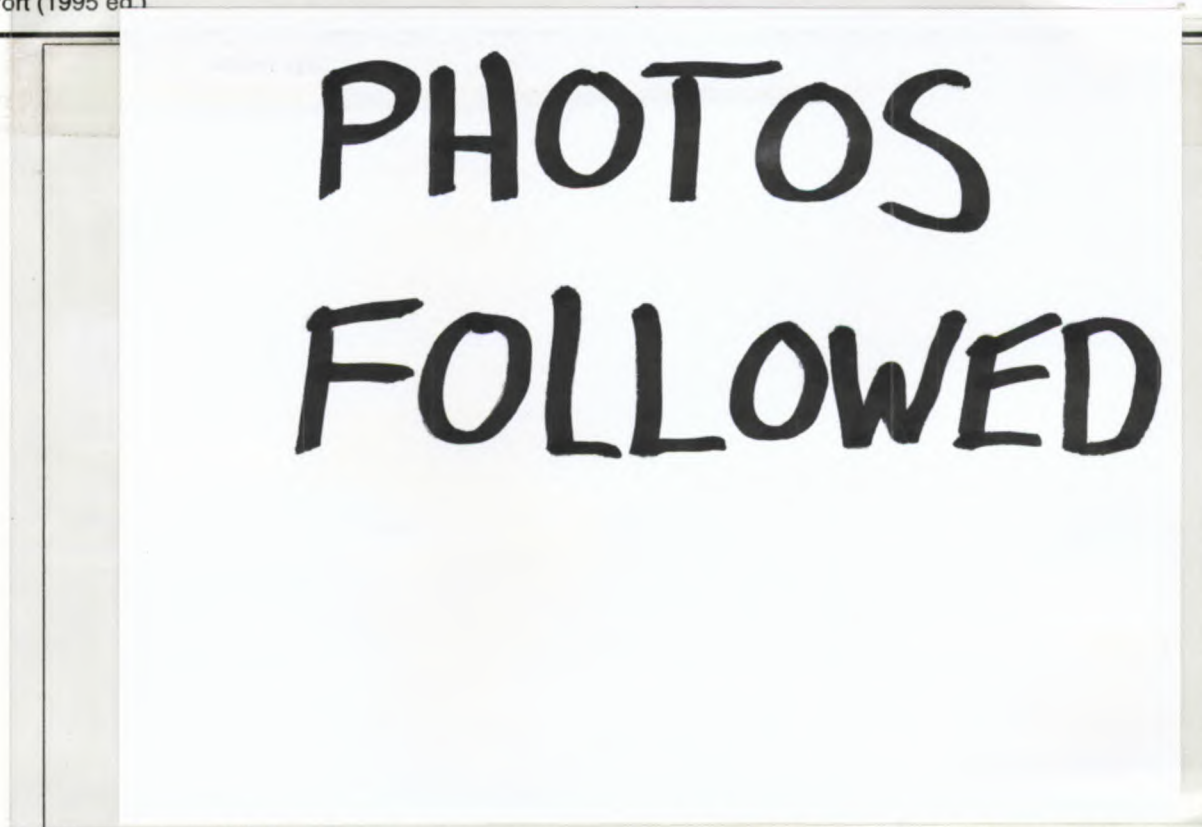

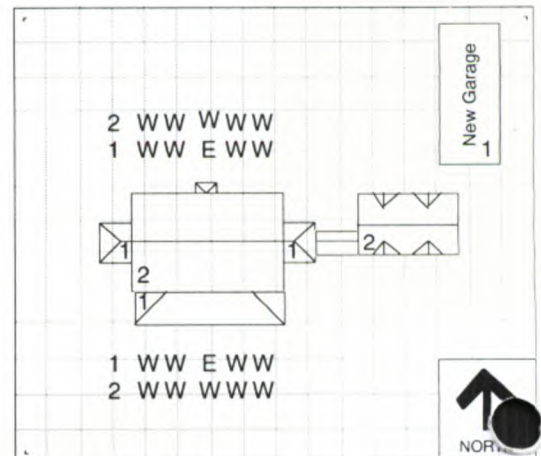

Description: Rectangular 2 story frame dwelling w/lateral gable roof; 1 story enclosed sun porch at W w/hipped roof; 1 story kitchen wing at E w/hipped roof; full facade 1 story hipped porch at waterfront facade; 1 story hipped entrance bay portico at land entrance; facade entrance has transom & sidelights; land entrance has leaded glass fanlight & sidelights; 1 story covered walk extends from kitchen to 2 story original garage; asbestos siding is original to the house; wooded site overlooking Beaufort River

Historical Data: owner has copies of original architect's drawings; house built for Commander (Dr.) and Mrs. F. P. Field, commanding officer of the nearby Naval Hospital; Com. Field is reported to have died of a heart attack on the day Japan attacked Pearl Harbor during World War II, 12/7/1941; architect was Thomas H. Voshell, of Charleston; plans dated 4 March 1940
