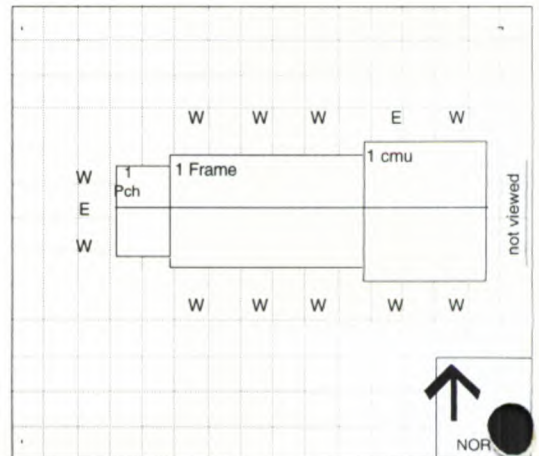

Description: 1 story rectangular 3 x 3 bay frame church w/front-facing gable composition shingle roof. 3x3 bay block addition at rear. Small square belltower at front of roof ridge w/hipped roof and rectangular louvered vents. Boxed cornice w/returns. Central entrance at facade flanked by single 6/6 double hung sash widows. 6/6 windows at each bay of side elevations.
